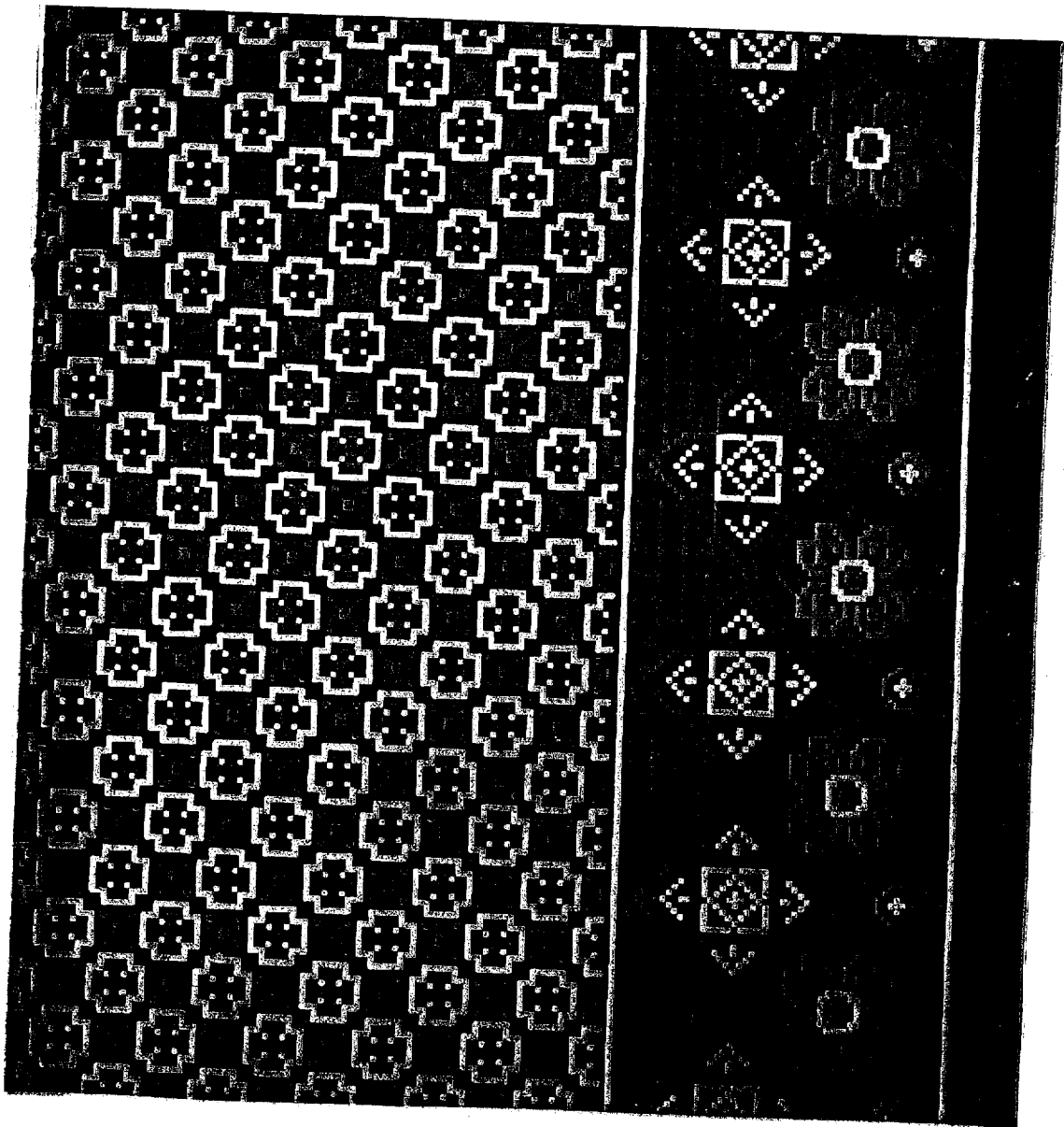

DESIGN FOR OIL-CLOTH.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 17,152, dated March 1, 1867.

Application filed January 22, 1867. Serial No. 225,200. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, CHARLES T. MEYER
and VICTOR E. MEYER, of Bergen, county of
Hudson, State of New Jersey, have originated
5 and designed a new Pattern for Floor Oil-
Cloths, Carpets, or other Fabrics, of which the
following is a full, clear, and exact description,
reference being had to the accompanying draw-
ing, making part of this specification, which
10 fully represents said design, and is sufficient,
without further aid, to enable any person
skilled in the art to repeat it for practical use.

The colors employed for the different por-
tions of this design may be varied to suit the
convenience or taste of the manufacturer. 15

The design or pattern for floor oil-cloths,
carpets, or other fabrics, as shown.
