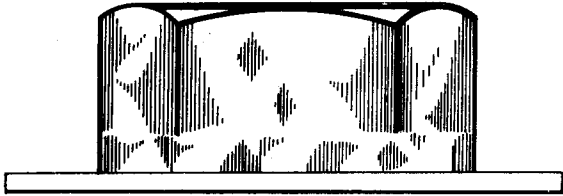

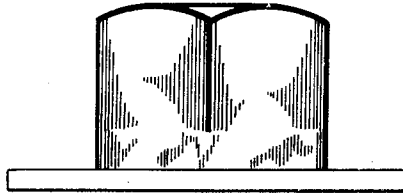

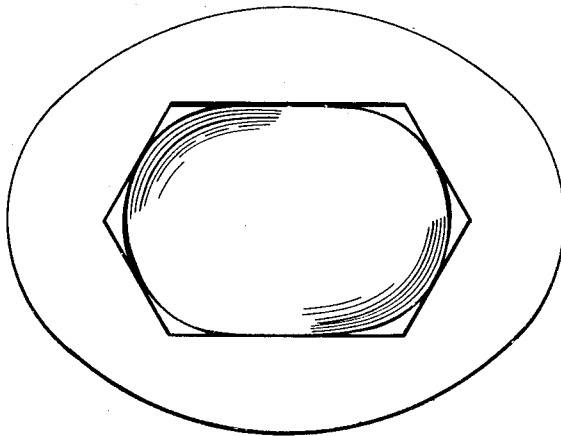

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM EDSON, a citizen of the United States, and resident of the city of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Hats, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevation of a hat crown illustrating my design. Fig. 2 is a front

elevation view. Fig. 3 is a top plan view showing my new design.
