



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Walter Mueller, a citizen of the United States, residing at Clifton, in the county of Passaic and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lady's Stocking, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein the figure is a side view of a stocking, showing my new design, the opposite side of the stocking being substantially identical with that shown.
