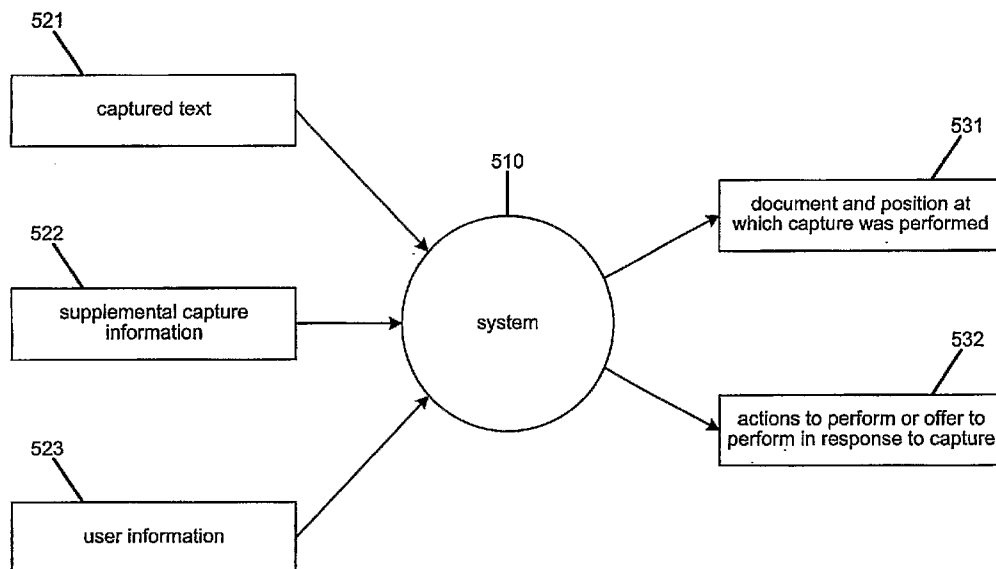

(54) Title: CAPTURING TEXT FROM RENDERED DOCUMENTS USING SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION



(57) Abstract: A system for processing a text capture operation is described. The system receives text captured from a rendered document in the text capture operation (521). The system also receives supplemental information (522) distinct from the captured text. The system determines an action to perform in response (532) to the text capture operation based upon both the captured text and the supplemental information.
