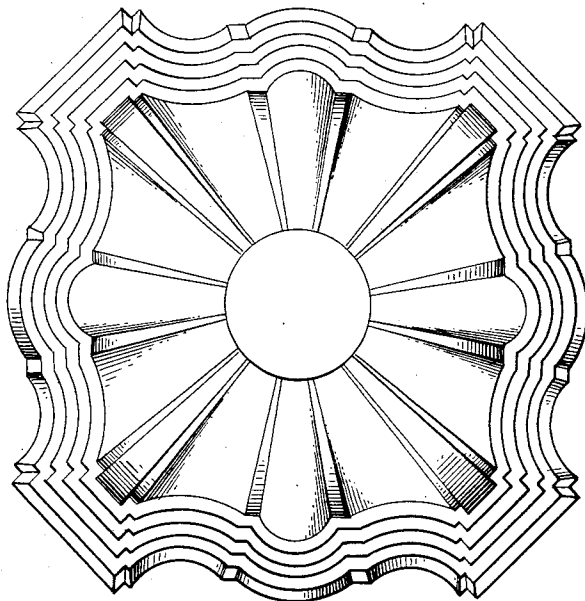
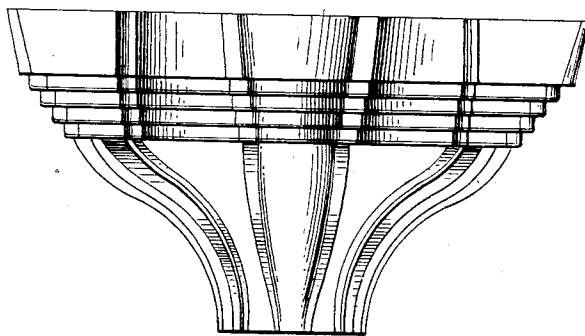

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HOWARD E. WATKINS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Summit, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Shells for Lighting-Fixtures or Similar Articles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
