DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of one side showing our new design, the material in phantom forming no part of the design;

FIG. 2 is a side view of the other side showing our new design, the material in phantom forming no part of the design;

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof, the material in phantom forming no part of the design;

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof, the material in phantom forming no part of the design;

FIG. 5 is an end view of one end thereof, the material in phantom forming no part of the design;

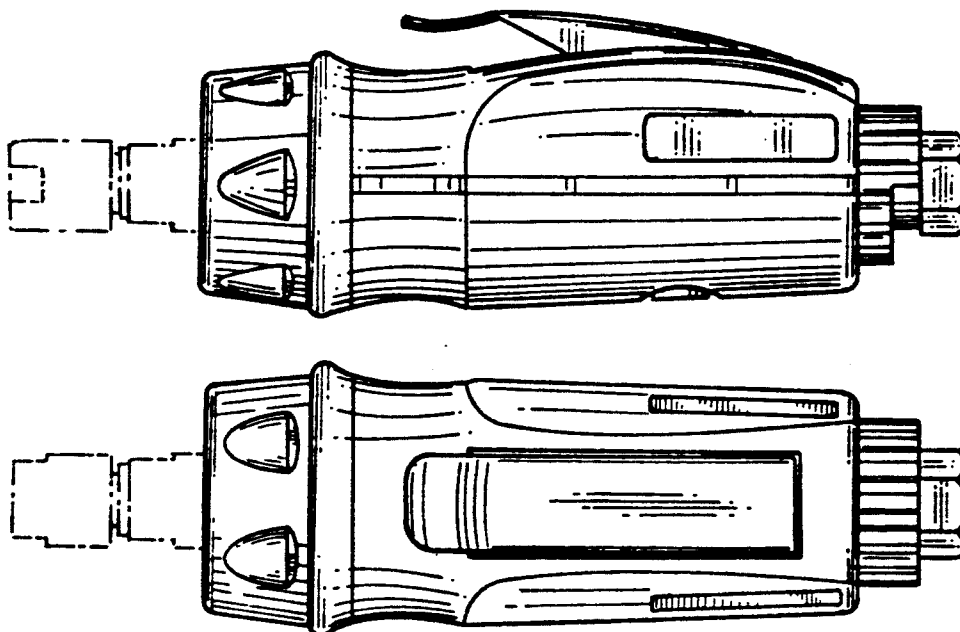
FIG. 6 is an end view of the other end thereof; the material in phantom forming no part of the design;

FIG. 7 is a side view of one side of a second embodiment, the other side being identical and the top, bottom and end views being substantially like FIGS. 3, 4, 5 and 6;

FIG. 8 is a side view of one side of a third embodiment, the other side being identical and the top, bottom and end views being substantially like FIGS. 3, 4, 5 and 6; and,

FIG. 9 is a side view of one side of a fourth embodiment, the other side being identical and the top, bottom and end views being substantially like FIGS. 3, 4, 5 and 6.

The broken line showing of the power tool in FIG. 7, 8 and 9 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



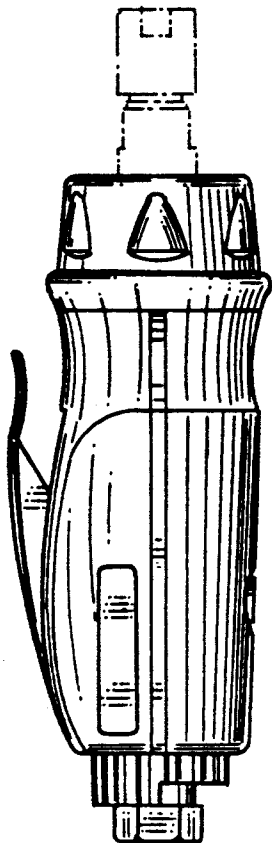

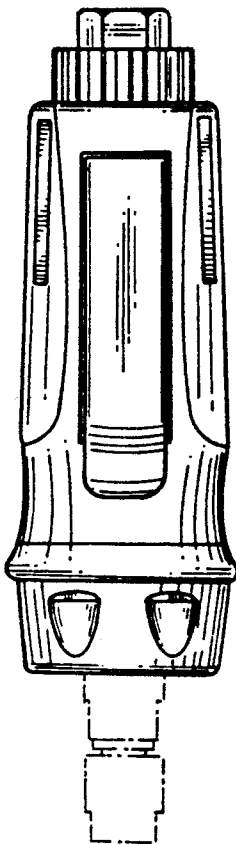

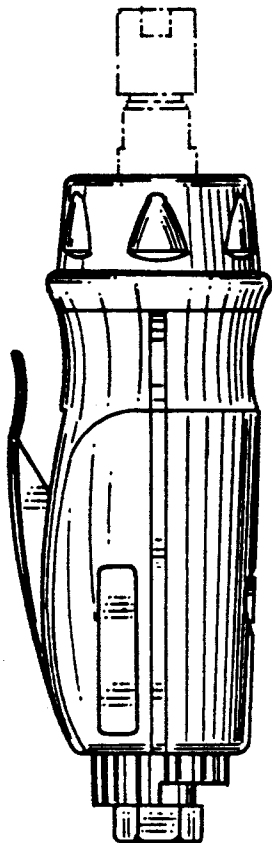

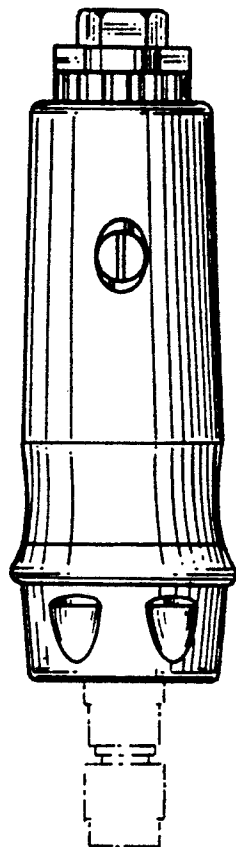

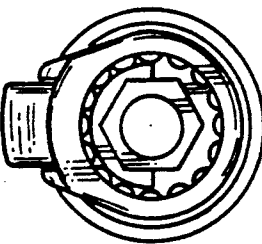

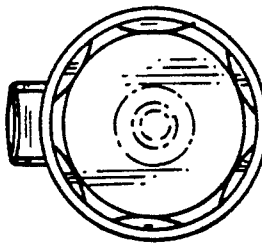

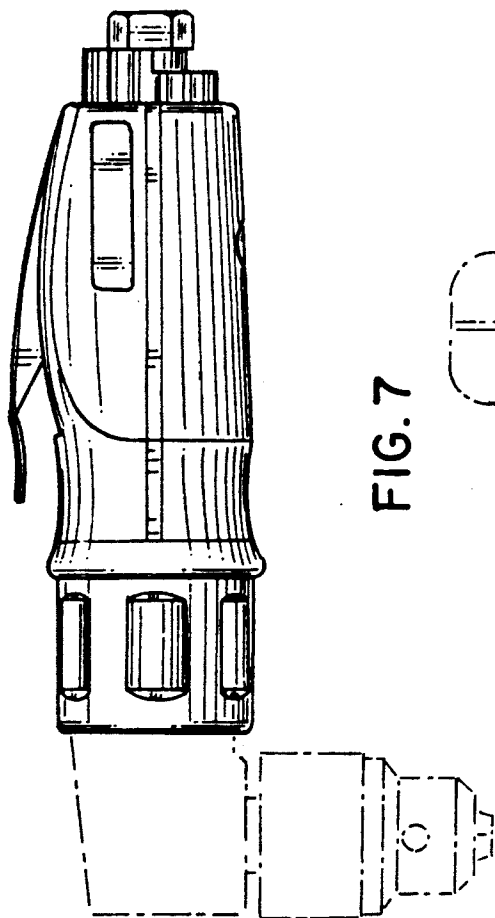

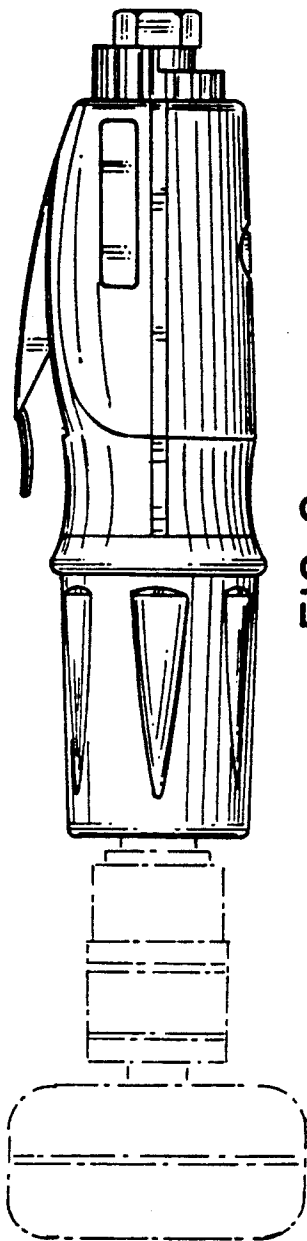

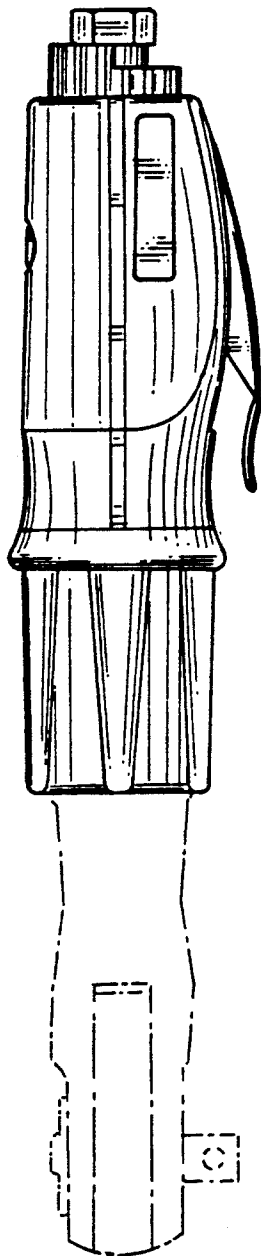
