[57] The ornamental design for a toy monorail vehicle, as shown and described.

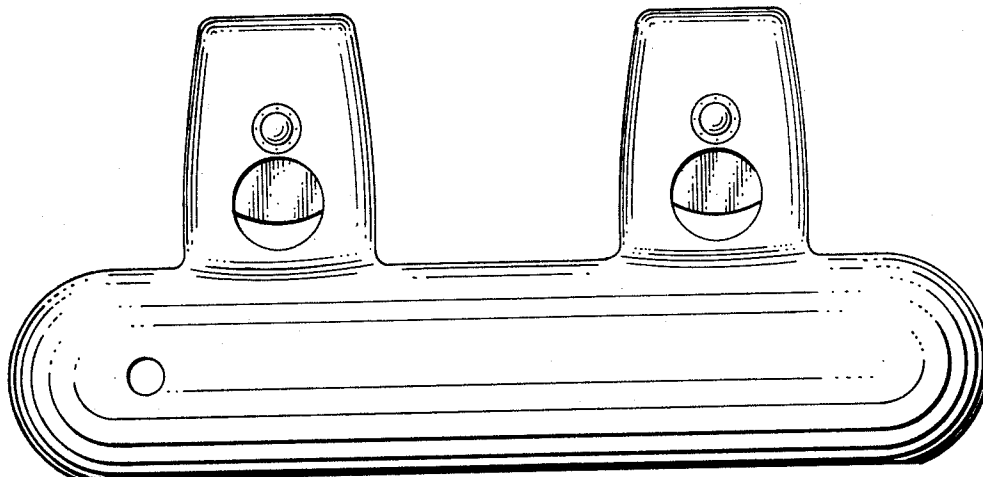
DESCRIPTION

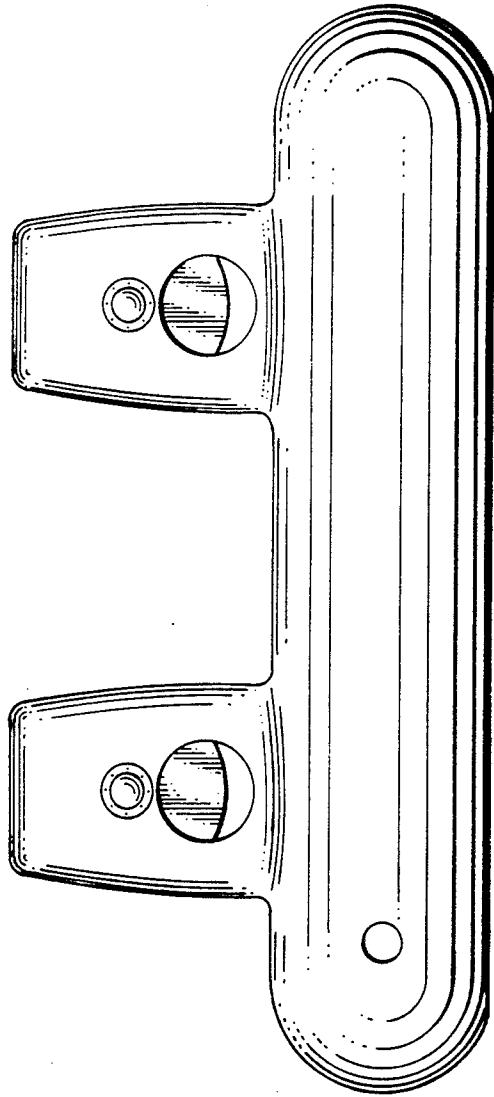

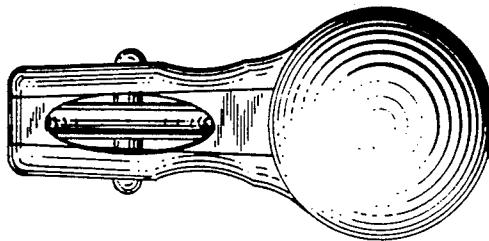
