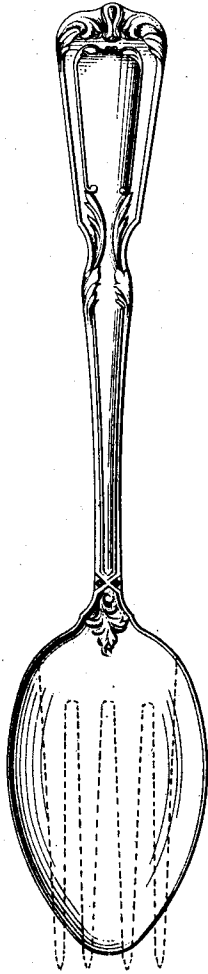

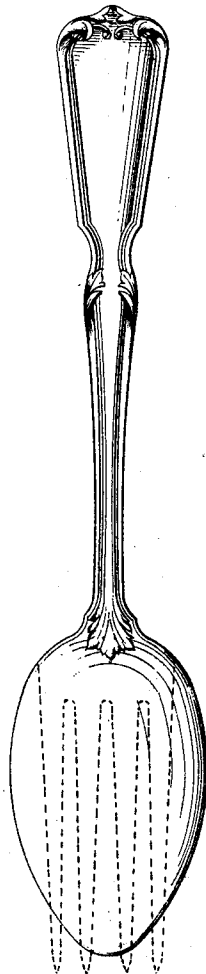

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE L. TURNER, a citizen of the United States, and resident of Taunton, in the county of Bristol and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Spoon or Fork, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
