

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed November 4, 1932. Serial No. 45,751. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM WILLHEIM, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 115 Central Park West, in the city of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a textile fabric showing one-fourth of the unit of my new

design, in which the border area ABEFG is covered with a ground as shown in portion ABCD. The other three corners, bearing the same design, are arranged in proper relation to the detailed illustration to complete the pattern.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a textile fabric or similar article as shown and described.
