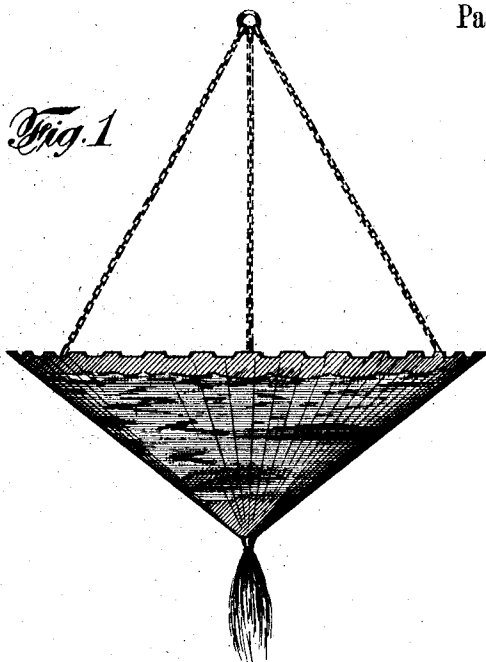
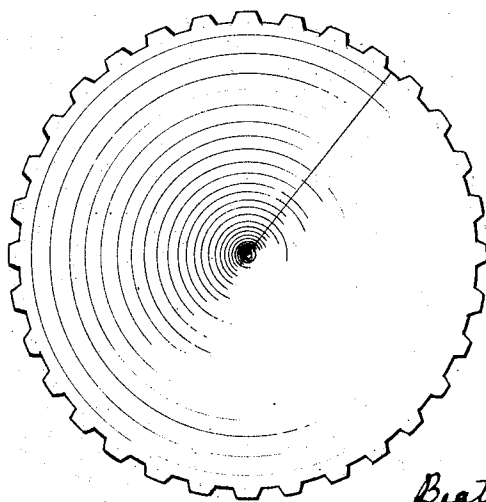

DESIGN FOR A LIGHT-FILTER.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, BEATRICE IRWIN, a subject of the King of England, and residing at New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Light-Filters, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying sheet of drawings, forming part thereof.

In the drawings Figure 1 is a vertical view of a light filter of translucent material embodying my new design, and Fig. 2 is a plan view of the light filter.
