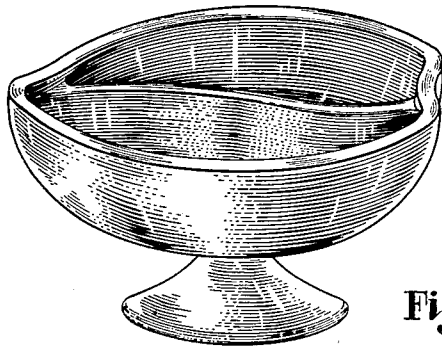

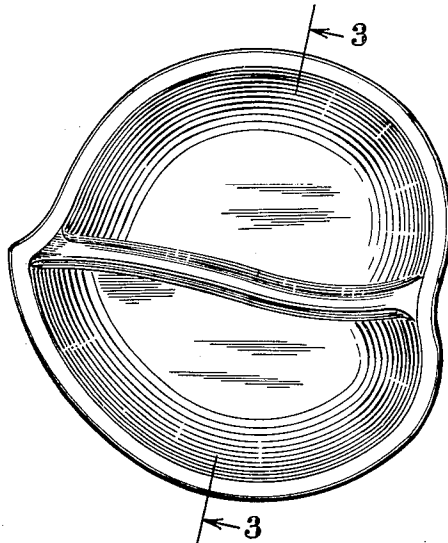

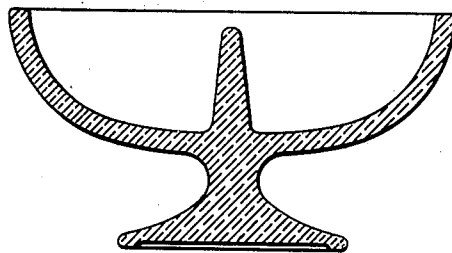

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Albert J. Dreitzer, a citizen of the United States of America and a resident of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Glass Sherbet or Article of Similar Nature, of which the following is the specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of the glass

sherbet or article of similar nature, showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a top plan view of the article shown in Figure 1.

Figure 3 is a vertical sectional view taken along line 3—3 of Figure 2 and in the direction of the arrows.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a glass sherbet or article of similar nature, substantially as shown.
