DESIGN FOR A LEATHER ROPE FOR BAG-HANDLES.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 36,789, dated February 9, 1904.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Albert Charles Fritsche, a citizen of the United States, residing at Philadelphia, county of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Leather Rope for Bag-Handles, reference being had to the accompanying drawings for an illustration of the same.

Figure 1 is a top or bottom plan view of a 10 section of the rope, and Fig. 2 is a side view.
