

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a spray cleaning unit, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top and front of a spray cleaning unit showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.












