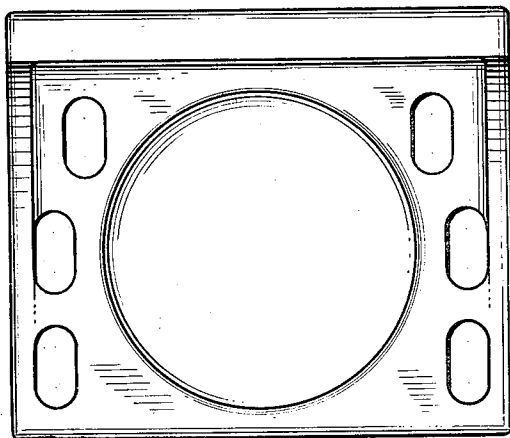

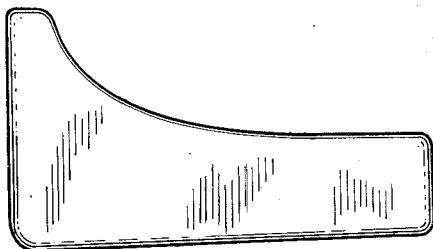

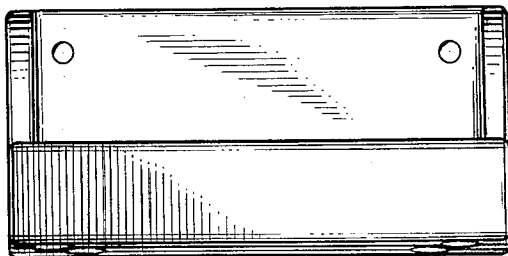

## DESIGN FOR A TUMBLER AND TOOTH PASTE HOLDER

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Jacques F. Levy, a citizen of the United States and resident of Manhattan, city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Tumbler and Tooth Paste Holder, of which the following is a specification:
