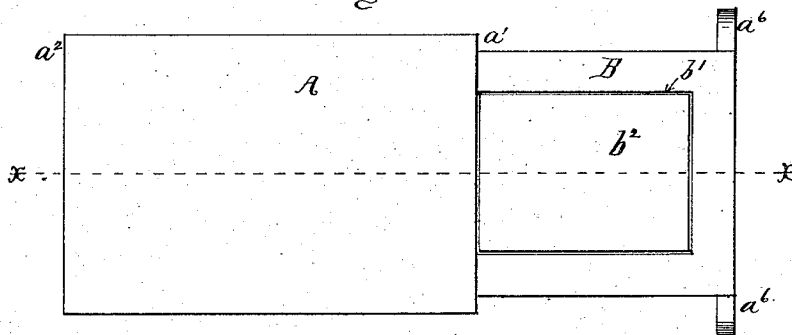
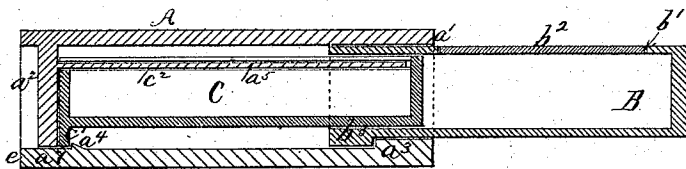

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## IMPROVEMENT IN TOY PUZZLE-BOXES.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. **158,106**, dated December 22, 1874; application filed July 10, 1874.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, PETER MCGURK, of Williamsburg, county of Kings, State of New York, have invented certain Improvements in Puzzle-Boxes, of which the following is a specification:

The object of my invention is to provide a puzzle-box which can be cheaply constructed and easily operated.

In order to describe my invention more fully, I refer to the accompanying drawing, forming a part of this specification.

Figure I is a plan view of my improved puzzle-box, when one of the inner boxes is drawn out. Fig. II is a sectional view of the same, taken on line *x x*, Fig. I. Fig. III is a sectional view taken on line *x x*, Fig. I, when both the inner boxes are drawn out.

A is the outer box or casing, open at *a*<sup>1</sup> and closed at *a*<sup>2</sup>. Into the drawer-box A slides another drawer-box, B, having on
