


DESIGN FOR A CAP.

Application filed July 18, 1927. Serial No. 22,793. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John C. Sutton, a citizen of the United States, residing at Rockford, in the county of Winnebago and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Cap of which the following is a specifical order.

In the drawing, wherein I have represented by surface shading the sheen of the inserts—

Figure 1 is a side view of a cap showing my new design; and,

Fig. 2 is a front view thereof.

I claim: for a Cap, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The invention comprises a skeleton cap presenting contrasting appearances between the inserts and the border edging substan-

tially as shown.
