
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a lifting handle for a toilet seat,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lifting handle for a toilet seat showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a reduced perspective view showing the lifting handle for a toilet seat in use; the broken lines depict environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design.














