DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a shoe upper showing my new design;



FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

The broken line showing of a shoe sole in FIGS. 1-5 and the area within are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design.












