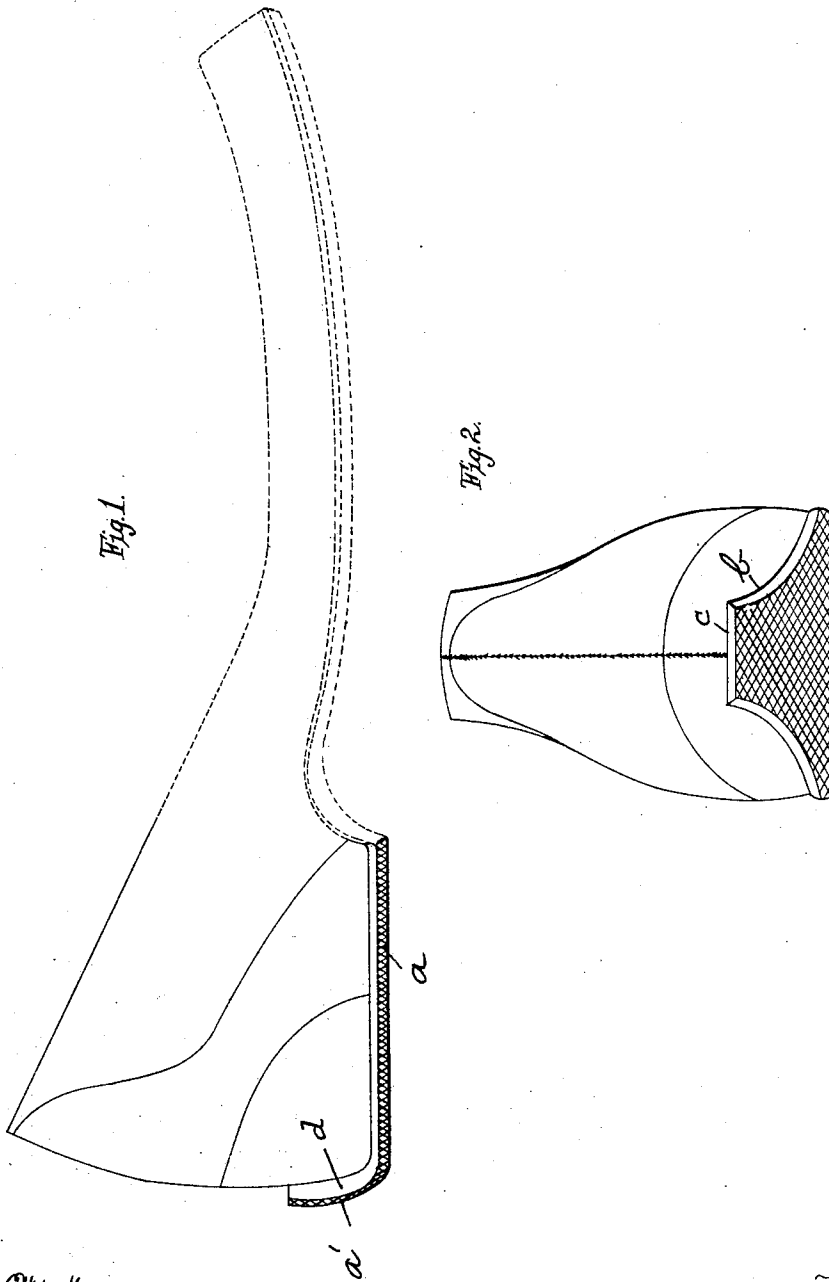

DESIGN FOR A RUBBER OVERSHOE.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, FREDERIC C. HOOD, a citizen of the United States, residing at Boston, Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Rubber Overshoe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In this drawing, Figure 1 is a side elevation. Fig. 2 a rear end view.

In this drawing the rubber overshoe is shown as provided with an ornamental heel tread portion having a corrugated surface as shown at *a*, this heel tread portion being carried upwardly around the heel of the

overshoe, as indicated at *a'*. The portion which is carried upwardly around the heel narrows as it goes upwardly on curved lines, as shown at *b* and terminates in a straight edged portion *c*. A slight smooth or beveled portion extends between the corrugated face of the tread portion and the body of the overshoe, as indicated at *d*.

I claim:—

The ornamental design for a rubber overshoe, as shown and described.
