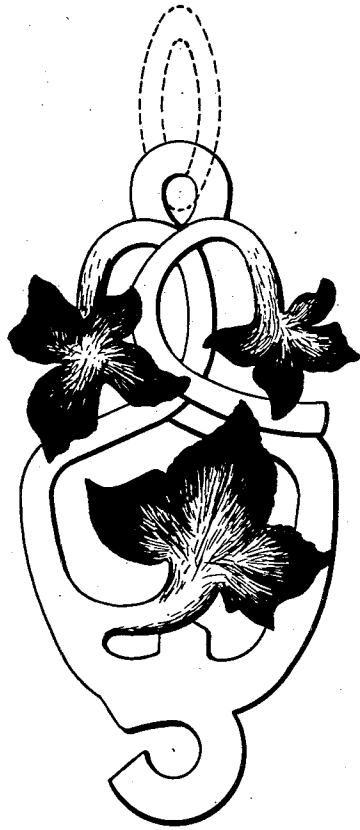

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Mary Daugull, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Drapery Hanger, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The single figure is a front elevational view of a drapery hanger, showing my new design.

The drapery hanger is of no appreciable thickness, and the back thereof is plain and unornamented.

The dominant features of my new design are shown in solid lines in the drawing.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a drapery hanger, substantially as shown and described.
