

(57) Abstract: A method (500, 600), and apparatus (110, 120) is provided for establishing a connection (111) between a terminal equipment TE (110) and mobile terminal MT (120). In one embodiment a control path is established between the MT and the TE over respective interfaces prior to a context activation associated with a dial-up request for an access session with a network (210). A command (401) is issued from the TE over the control path to set information related to the context activation. The information is preferably encoded and transferred over the control path in a native transfer mode and decoded prior to an issuance of the dial up request.
