DESIGN FOR TYPE.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

I, WILLIAM H. PAGE, of Norwich, in the county of New London, State of Connecticut, have invented and produced a new and original Design of an Alphabet of Letters for printing purposes, named "Caxton."

The nature of my design is for an alphabet of letters, as shown and described by the accompanying impressions of the letters.

The letters may be printed as shown, or in a combination for colors, as shown in Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7. I claim as my invention—
