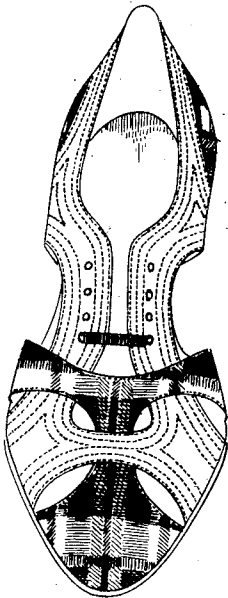

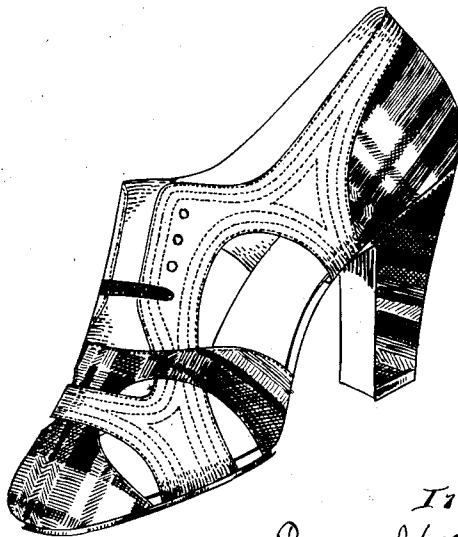

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Samuel Weinstat, a citizen of the United States, residing at 107-23 103rd Street, Ozone Park, Long Island, New York, in the State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe or Article of Analogous Nature, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the
