






To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Clifford W. Sandley, a citizen of the United States, residing at Madison, county of Dane, and State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Illuminated Coin Tray, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of an illuminated coin tray, showing my design; Fig. 2, a side elevational view of the same; Fig. 3, a front elevational view; and Fig. 4, a rear elevational view.
