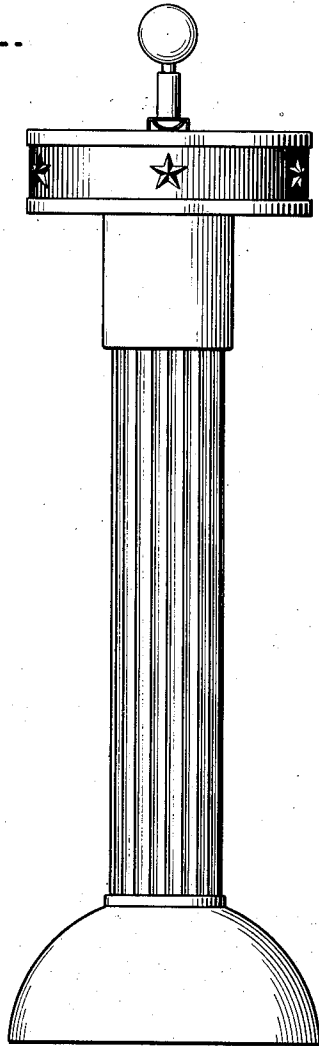
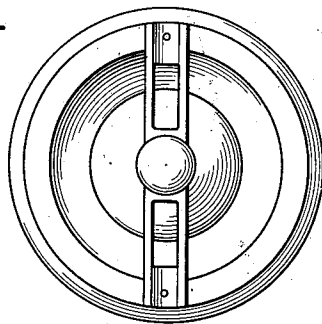

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Charles Hardy, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Ash Stand, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of the ash stand showing my new design, and

Fig. 2 is a top plan view thereof.
