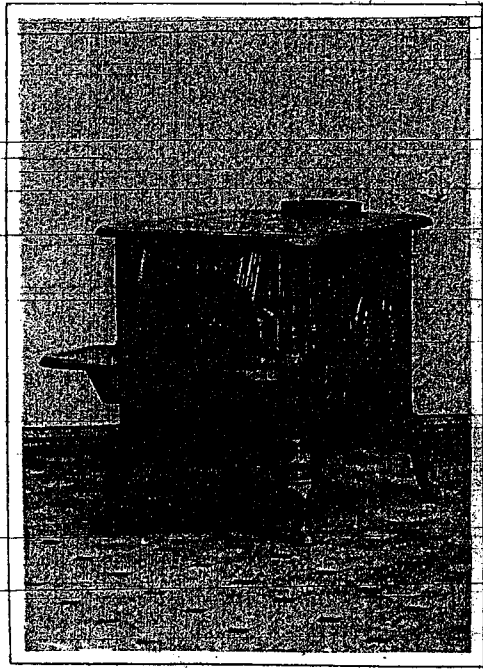

Design for a Cooking Stove.

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Conrad Harris and Paul W. Joiner, both of Cincinnati, County of Hamilton, State of Ohio, have invented a new and improved design for coal and wood cooking stoves, to be known and called, the "Pentine"; and we do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and to letters of reference marked thereon, wherein letter A shows a view of the front and side plates of the stove with doors attached.

What we claim as our invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent is the moulding and configuration upon the doors as shown in annexed drawings, so arranged and combined as to form an ornamental design for a coal and wood cooking stove.
