



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Israel Berman, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in Little Falls, county of Herkimer, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Slipper of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
