[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a heated water bath for conditioning dental hydrocolloids, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a heated water bath for conditioning dental hydrocolloids showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being identical in appearance; and

FIG. 6 is a front perspective view thereof.











