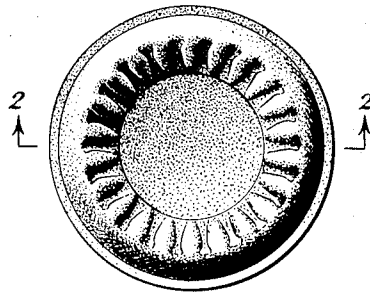
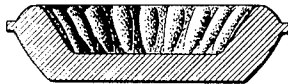

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that FERDINAND PETERSON, a citizen of Sweden and resident of Bronx, in the county of Bronx and State of New York, has invented a new, original, and ornamental design for a Wafer or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof, in which,

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a wafer embodying my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a sectional view thereof taken along lines 2—2 of Fig. 1.
