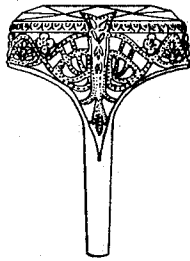

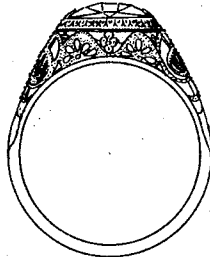

DESIGN FOR A FINGER RING.

Application filed January 27, 1925. Serial No. 12,159. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JACK MARTIN, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Finger Rings, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is an edge elevation of a finger ring embodying the invention, the opposite elevation being identical with that shown;

Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the ring of Fig. 1 90° removed from that of Fig. 1, the elevation of the opposite side of the ring being identical with that shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a finger ring as shown.
