


DESIGN FOR A PEPPER OR SALT BOX.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 22,487, dated May 30, 1893.

Application filed May 2, 1893. Serial No. 472,796. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH WALTER, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for a Pepper or Salt Box, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description.

Reference is to be had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part of this specification, in which similar letters of reference indicate corresponding parts in both the figures.

Figure 1 is a side elevation of a pepper or salt box showing my design; and Fig. 2 is a sectional side elevation of the same.

The leading feature of my design consists in the representation of the neck of a bottle A ornamented at its lower end by a bottom B and at its top by a perforated seal C.

I claim--

The design for a pepper or salt box as herein shown and described.
