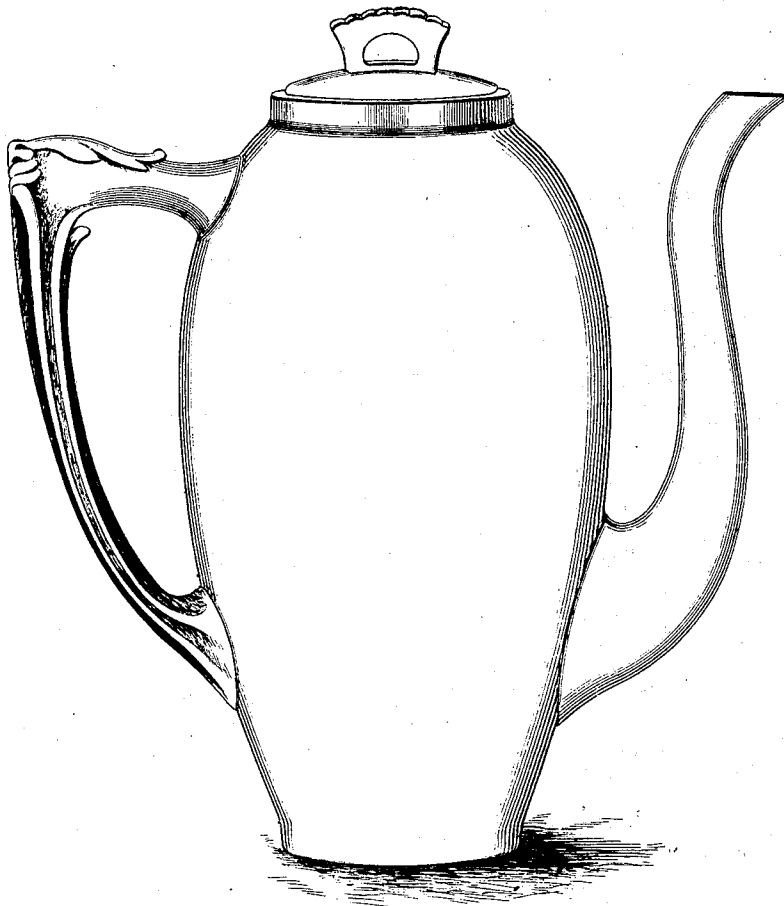

DESIGN FOR A COFFEE-POT OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 36,429, dated July 14, 1903.

Application filed June 3, 1903. Serial No. 159,982. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:
