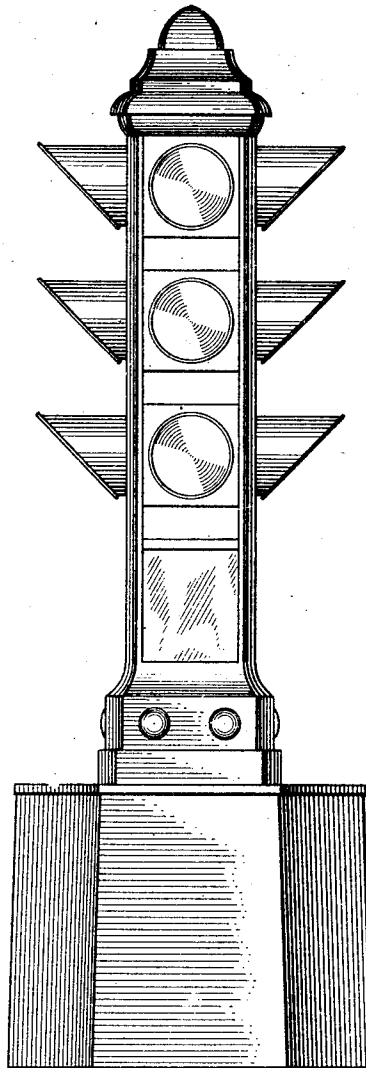
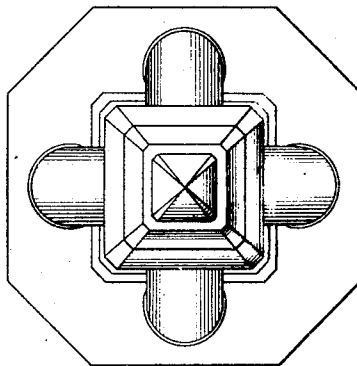

DESIGN FOR A TRAFFIC SIGNAL.

Application filed July 12, 1926. Serial No. 18,331. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES T. MARTON, a citizen of the United States, residing at Rochester, in the county of Monroe and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Traffic Signals, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
