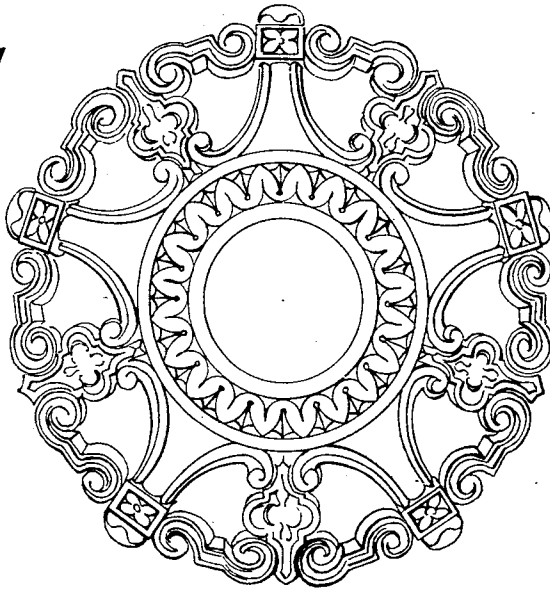
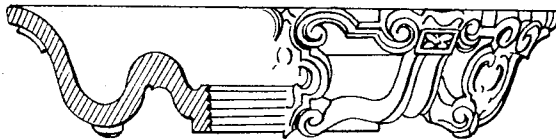

DESIGN FOR A LIGHTING-FIXTURE PART.

Application filed November 20, 1924. Serial No. 11,419. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES A. KUSTER, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the borough of Queens, Queens County, city and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lighting Fixture Part, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a bottom plan view; and

Fig. 2 is a side elevation of a lighting fixture part showing my new design, said view being partly in section.
