**DESCRIPTION**

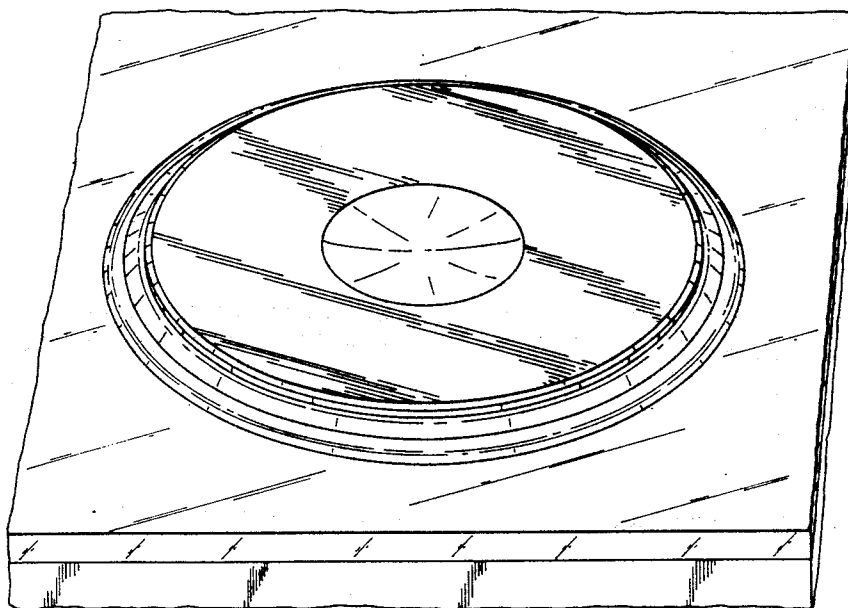
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined electric hotplate and mounting surface therefor, showing our new design;

The inner and outer surfaces of the cooking appliance base plate are flat.



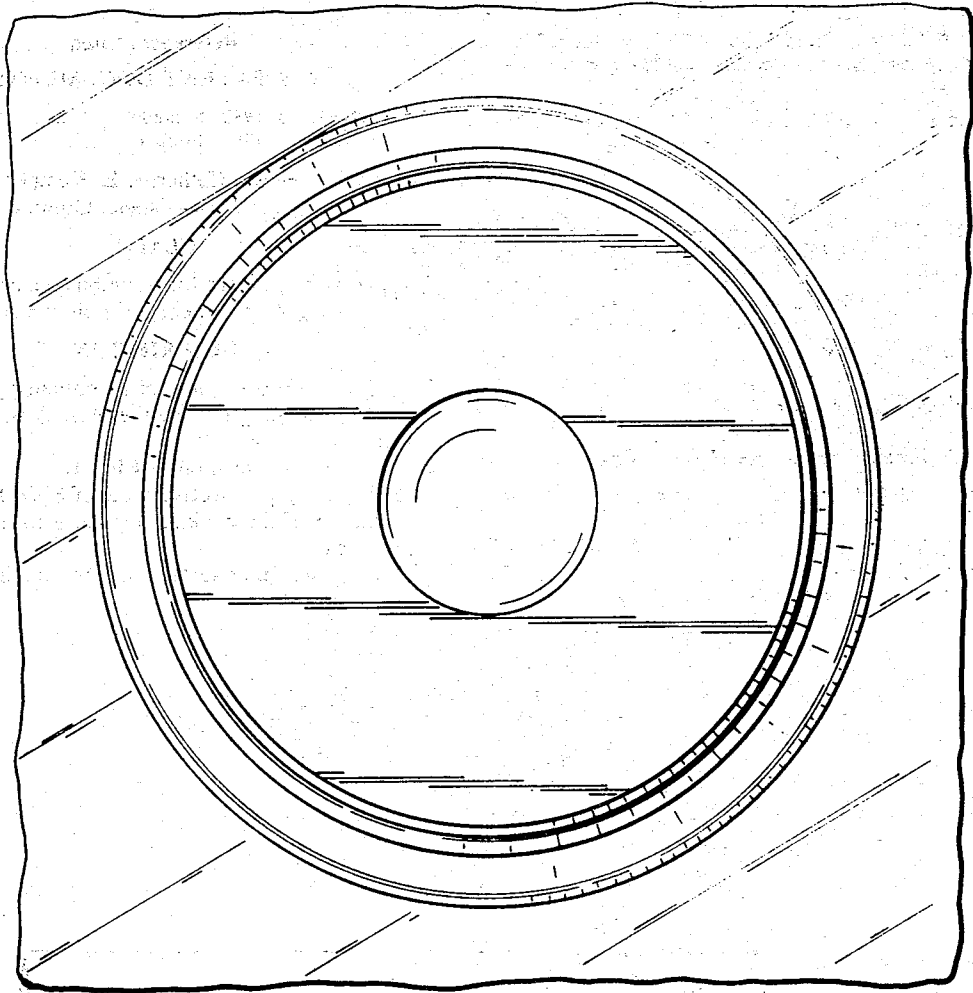
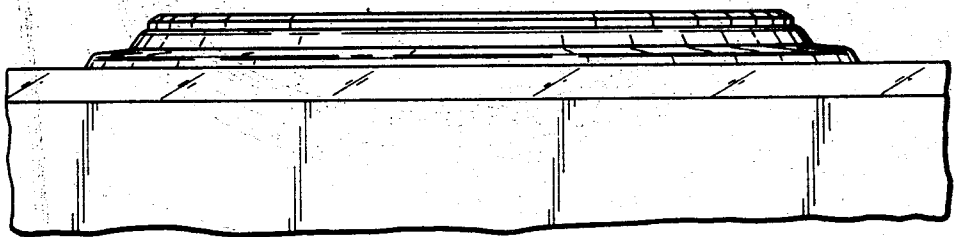

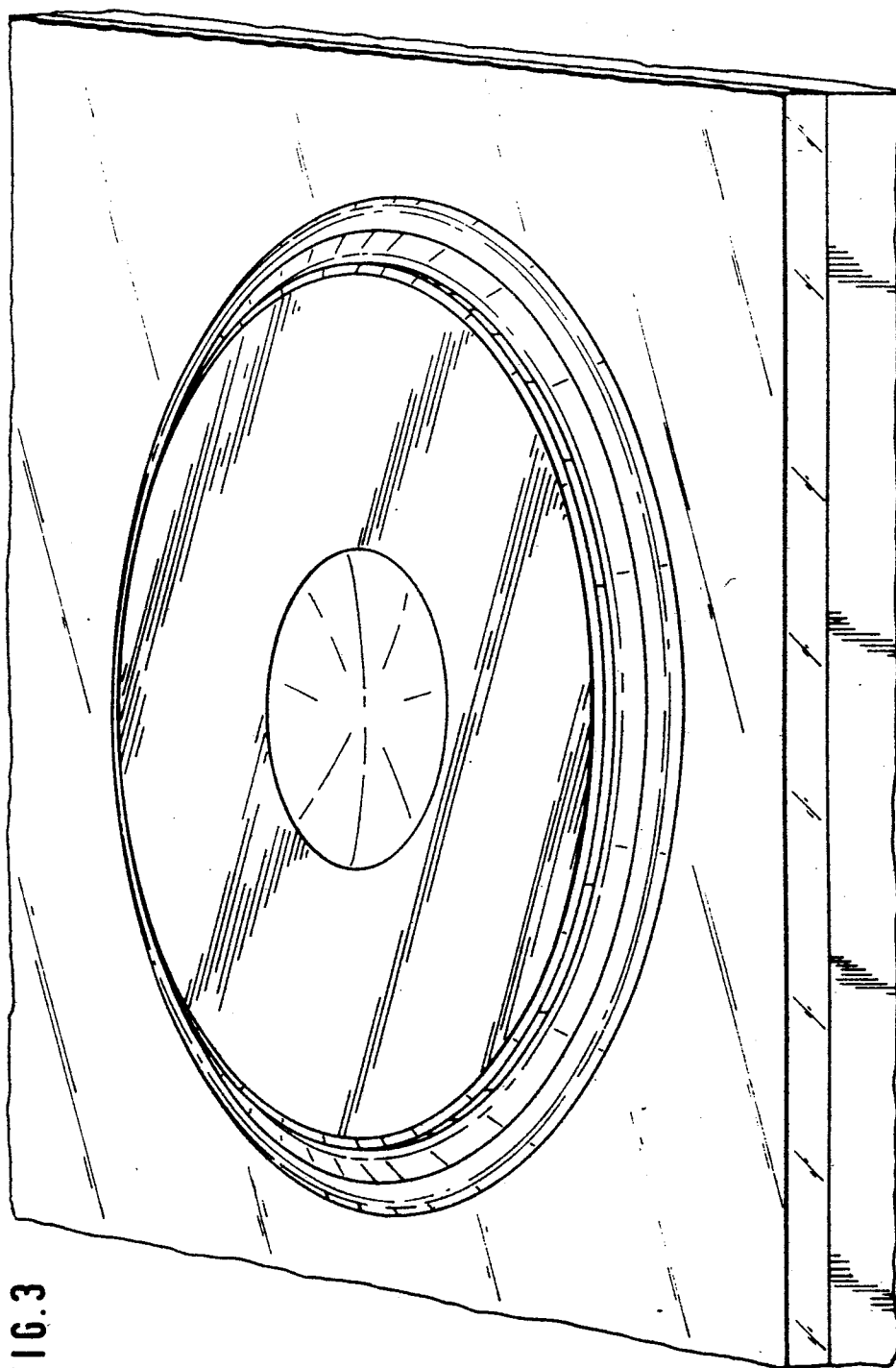
