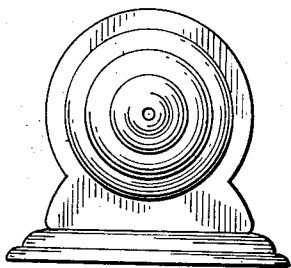

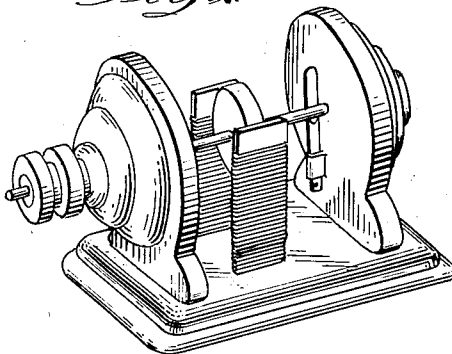

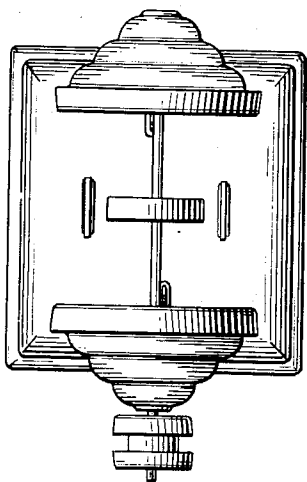

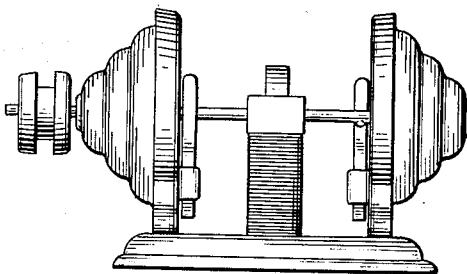
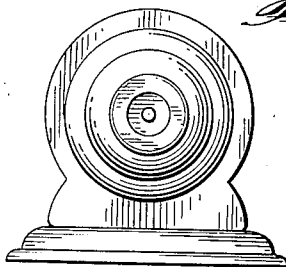

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Edward D. Wilk, a citizen of the United States, and resident of Elmwood Park, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Toy Electric Motor, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof:

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a toy electric motor, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a top plan view of the same.

Fig. 3 is a side elevational view of the same.

Fig. 4 is an end-on elevational view from one side of the same.

Fig. 5 is an end-on elevational view from the opposite side of the same.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a toy electric motor, substantially as shown.
