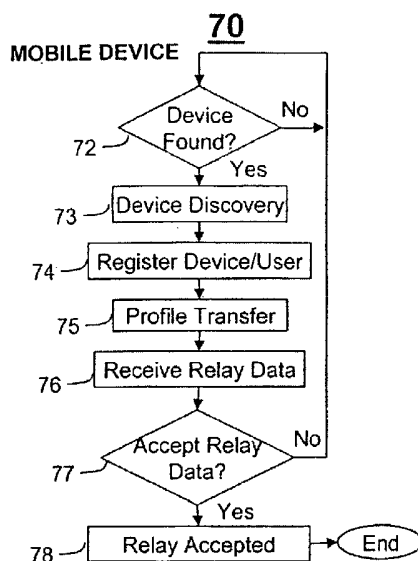

(57) Abstract: A system (30) and method (60, 70, 80, and 90) of using a mobile device as an information relay among multiple user environments can include the steps of capturing (76 and 78) a set of application settings and data (or relay data) from a first electronic device during an active session of an application in a first user environment using the mobile device and transferring (87) the set of application settings and data (or relay data) from the mobile device to a second electronic device for continuity of the active session in a second user environment.
