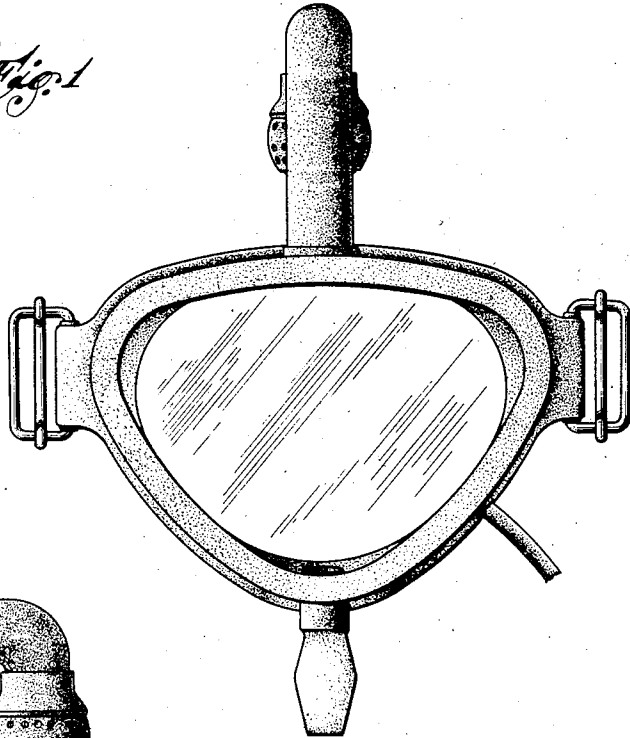

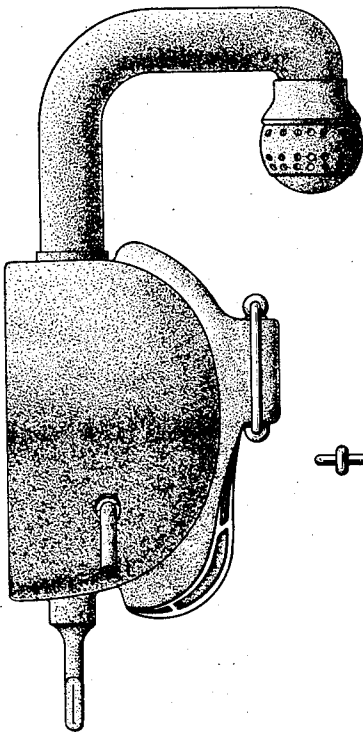

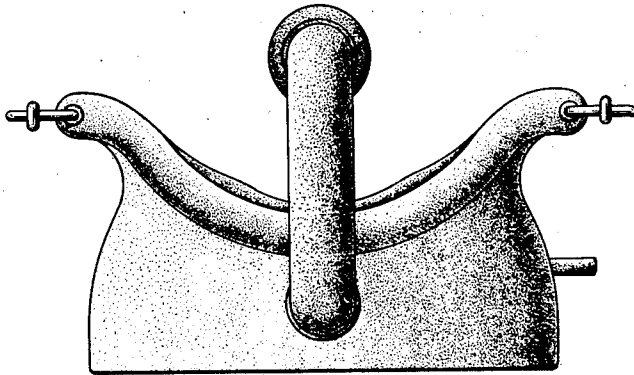

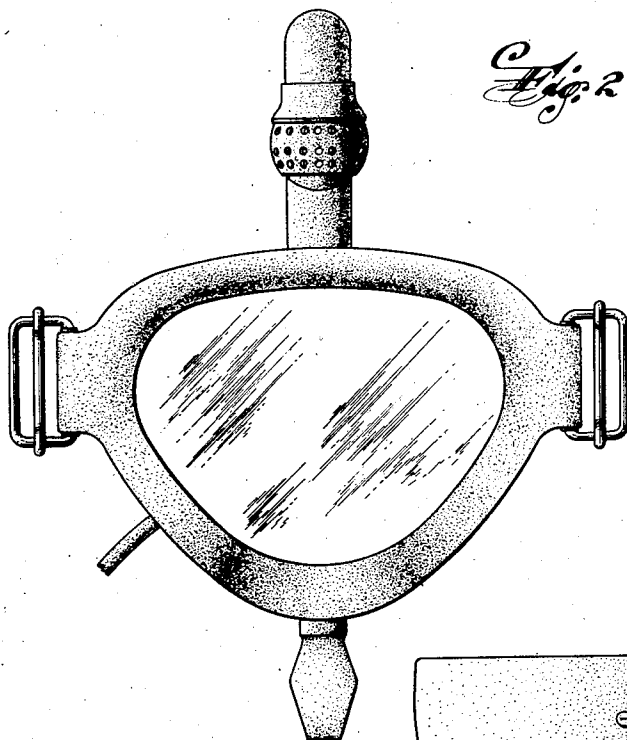

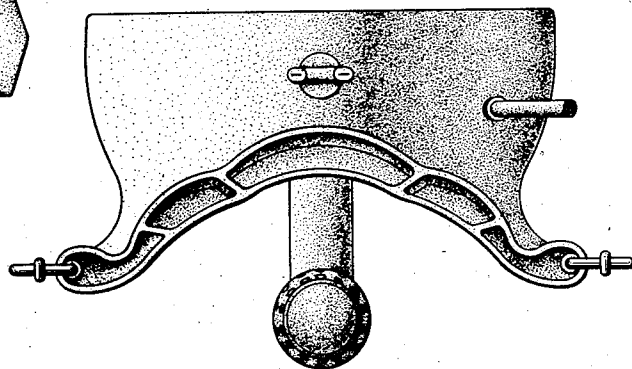

**DESIGN FOR A SWIMMER'S MASK**

**Charles H. Wilen, Laguna Beach, Calif.**

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Charles H. Wilen, a citizen of the United States, residing at Laguna Beach, in the county of Orange, State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Swimmer's Mask, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings forming a part thereof.

In the drawings:

Figure 1 is a front view of my new design of swimmer's mask, as it appears when worn.

Figure 2 is a view of the mask looking at the side which fits the face of the user.

Figure 3 is a top plan view looking down on Figure 1.

Figure 4 is a bottom view looking upwardly at Figure 2.

Figure 5 is an end view of Figure 1 looking from right to left.

I claim:

The ornamental design of a swimmer's mask, substantially as shown.
