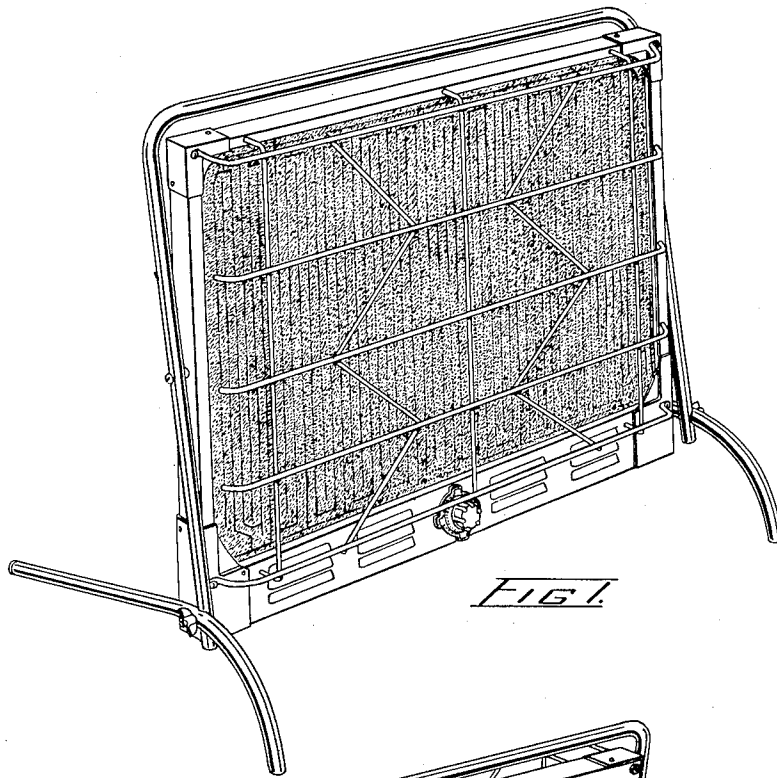

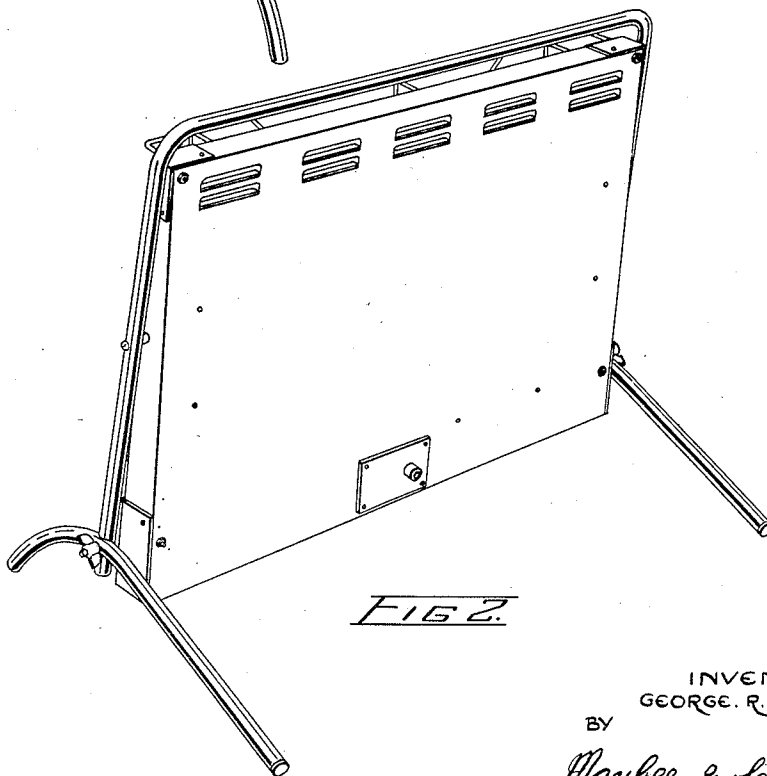

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George Ross Johnson, a citizen of Canada, residing at Toronto, Province of Ontario, Canada, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Portable Electric Heater, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a portable electric heater, viewed from the front and from one side, showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is another perspective view thereof, viewed from the rear and from the other side.
