

BLOWOUT TOY OR THE LIKE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Danny Kaye and Edward Dukoff, both citizens of the United States, residing, respectively, at Beverly Hills, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, and North Hollywood, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Blowout Toy or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

On the drawing,

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a blowout toy or the like embodying our new design, the members of the toy being in the position they assume when not blown up; and

Fig. 2 is a view of the toy shown in Fig. 1, to reduced scale, looking at it from the opposite direction, when the members are blown up.

The characteristic features of our design reside in those portions shown in full lines in the drawing.

We claim:

The ornamental design for a blowout toy or the like, substantially as shown and described.
