

(54) Title: OPHTHALMOLOGIC APPLANATION PRISM REPLACEMENT SYSTEM



(57) Abstract: A replaceable applanation prism (20) for an eye examining instrument is made to be discarded after each use. A bendable tab (40) molded on the prism (20) is deformed by a strain gauge (45) as the prism (20) is inserted into a prism holder (50), and a signal from the strain gauge (45) is used to verify that a previously unused prism (20) has been inserted into the holder (50). A microprocessor (60) is programmed to recognize the signal produced by initial deformation of the prism tab (40) so as to proceed with an eye examination only after receiving the strain gauge (45) signal verifying that a previously unused prism (20) has been inserted.
