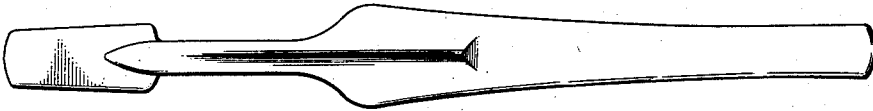

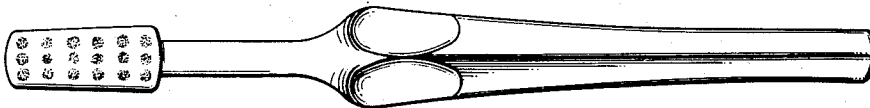

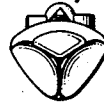

## TOOTHBRUSH

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Alfred F. MacDonald, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Toothbrush, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a toothbrush, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

Figure 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

Figure 4 is an end view at the brush end; and

Figure 5 is an end view of the handle.
