The ornamental design for a set of cards having partial borders, as shown and described.

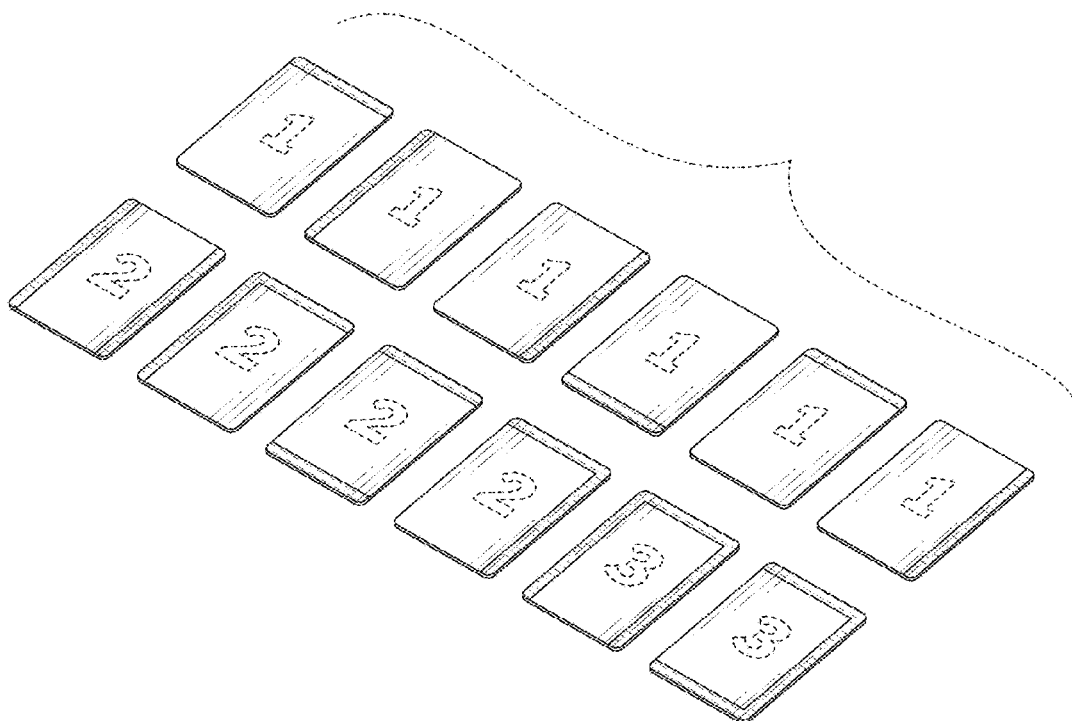
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a set of cards having partial borders, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and, FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof.

The broken lines in the figures depict portions of the set of cards having partial borders that form no part of the claimed design. The rear elevational view of the set of cards forms no part of the claimed design.

The dash-dot-dash line showing the bracket is included in the drawing to show the relationship or order of the set of cards and forms no part of the claimed design.

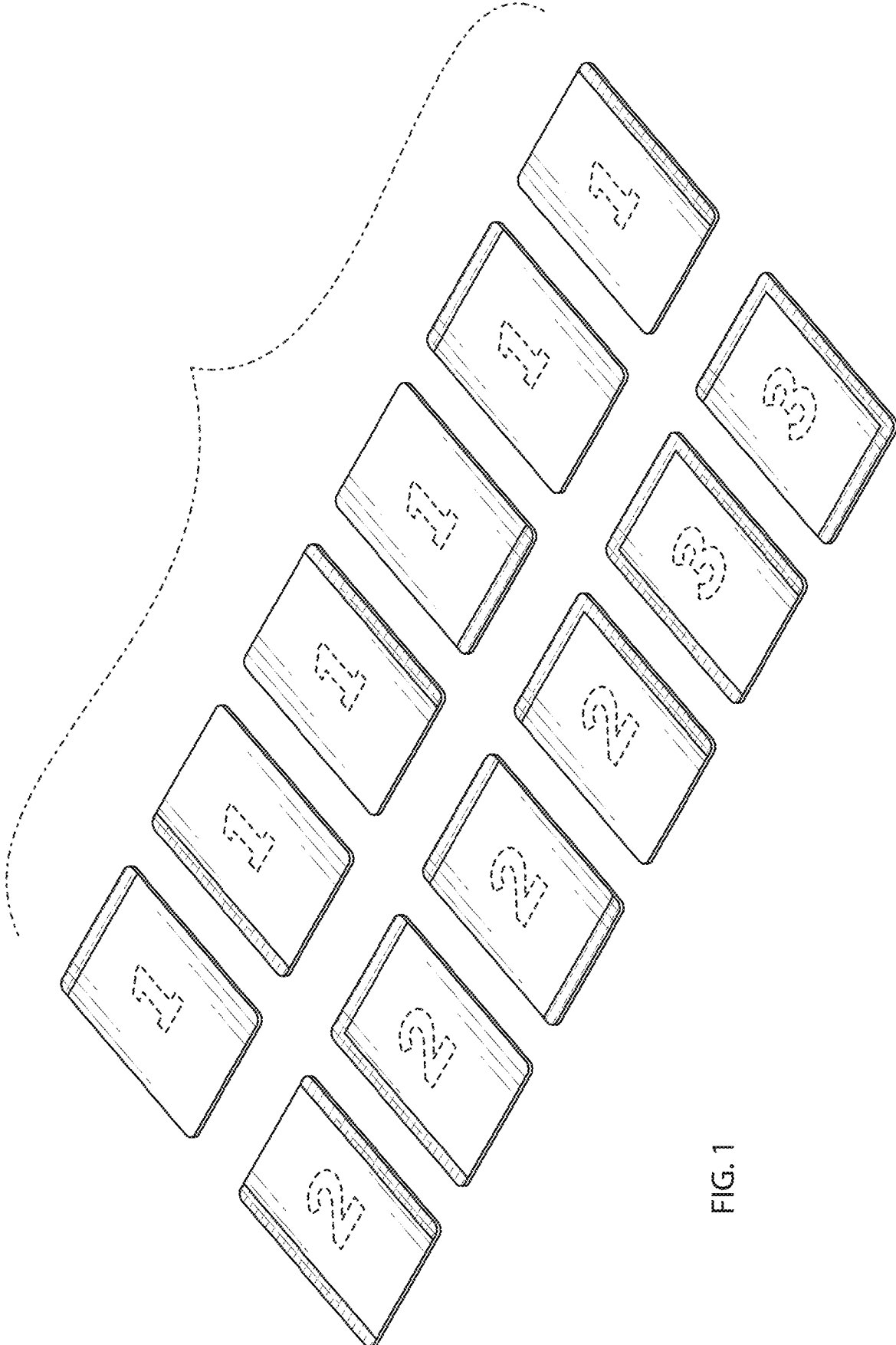

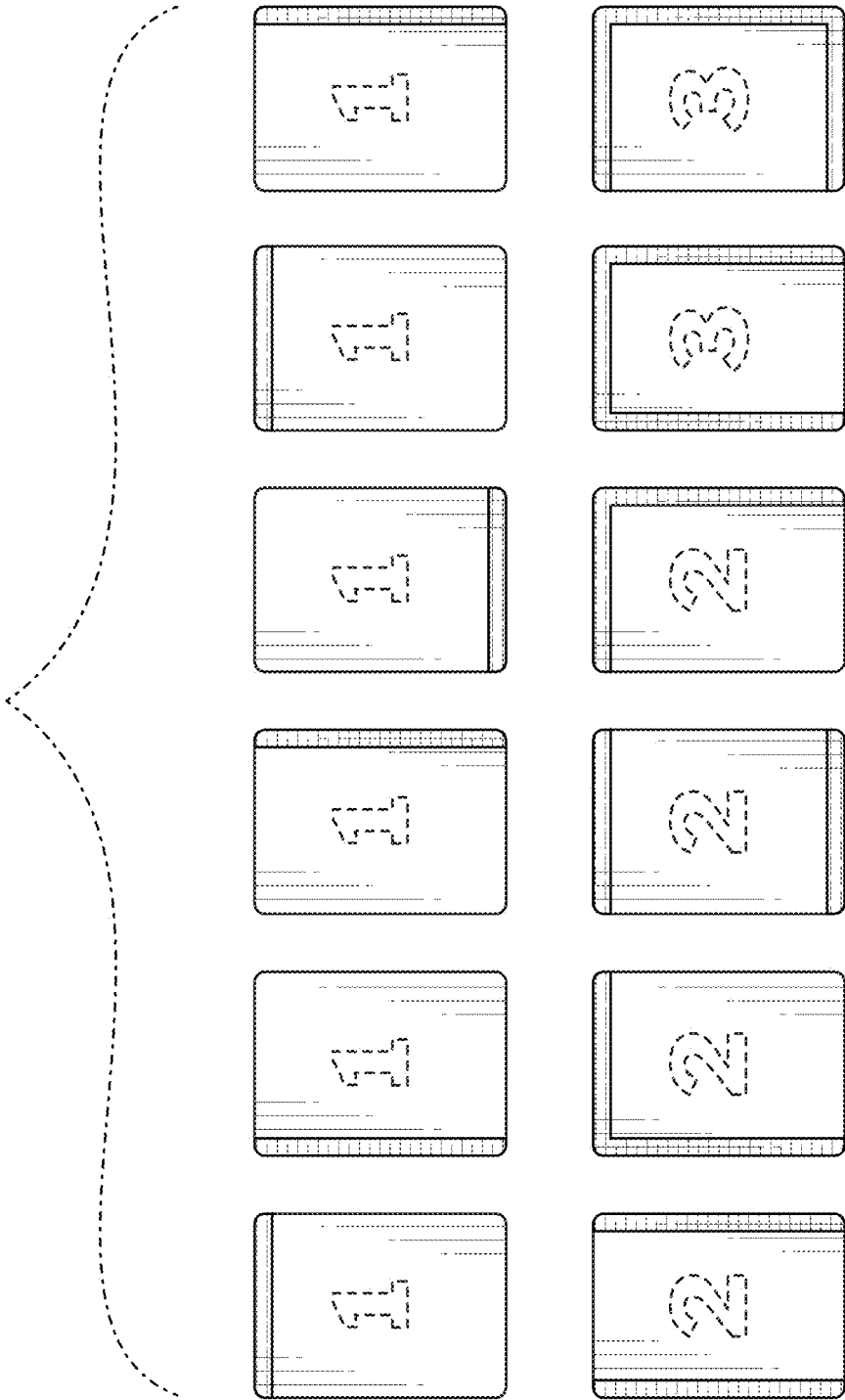

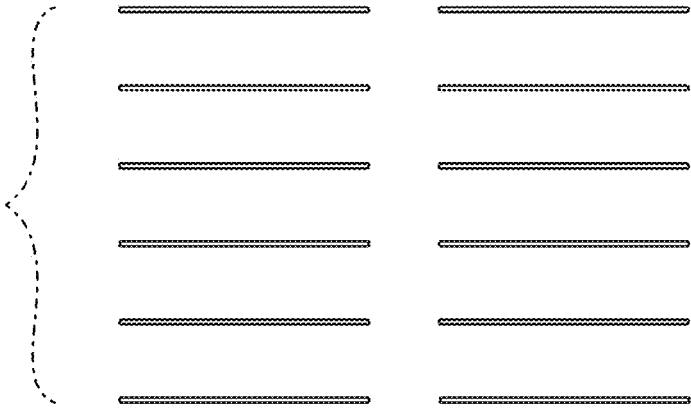

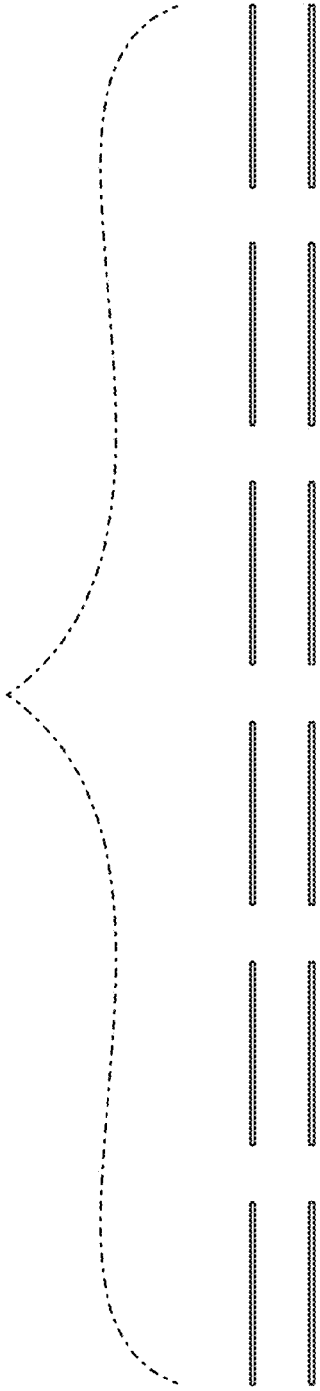
