

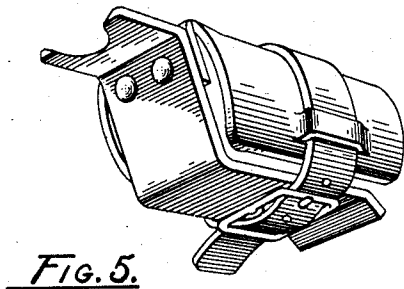
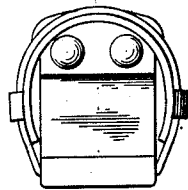
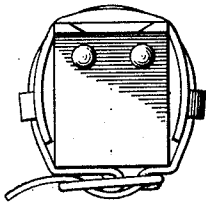
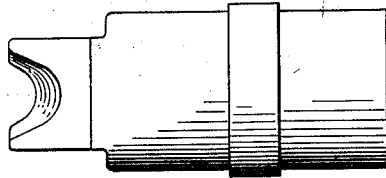
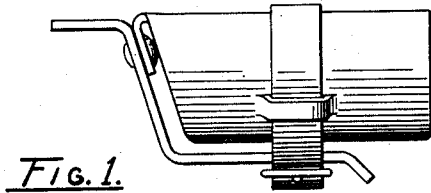

GRAPE STEM CUTTER

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Stanley Robinson, a citizen of the United States, residing at 1458 Poplar Avenue, Fresno, county of Fresno, and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Grape Stem Cutter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a grape stem cutter showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a top plan view of the grape stem cutter.

Fig. 3 is an end elevation of the grape stem cutter as viewed from the left end of Fig. 1.

Fig. 4 is an end elevation of the end of the grape stem cutter opposite to that shown in Fig. 3.

Fig. 5 is a perspective view of the grape stem cutter.
