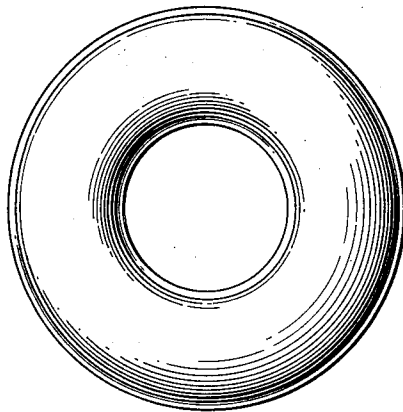
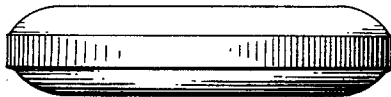

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CLARENCE A. CRANE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cleveland, in the county of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Confection and Chewing-Gum, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
