


To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that the undersigned, Walton C. Marsh, a citizen of the United States, residing in Belleville, Illinois, has invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Brush or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a fountain brush, showing the new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof; and

Fig. 3 is a transverse sectional view thereof on the line 3—3 of Fig. 2.

The dominant features of my design reside in the portions shown in full lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain brush or the like, substantially as shown and described.
