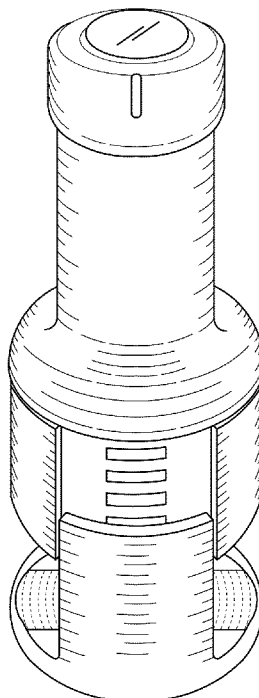
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the front and bottom views of my new flashlight showing my new design, where a cover is extended away from a flashlight housing;
FIG. 2 is perspective view showing the left side and bottom views thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;

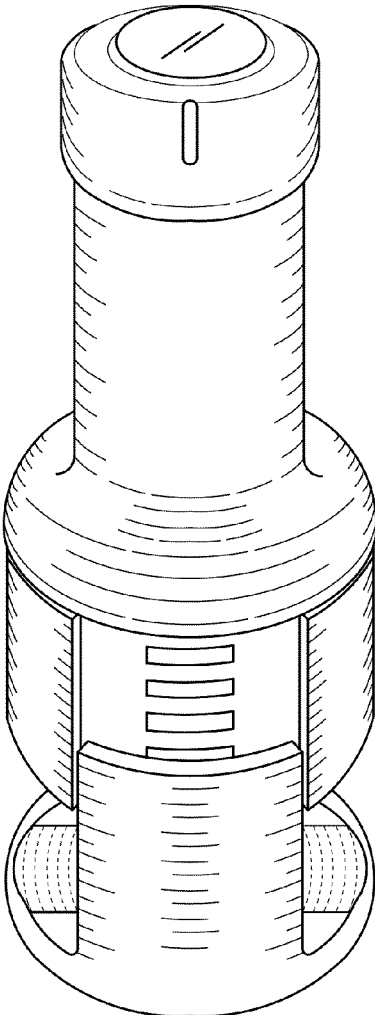

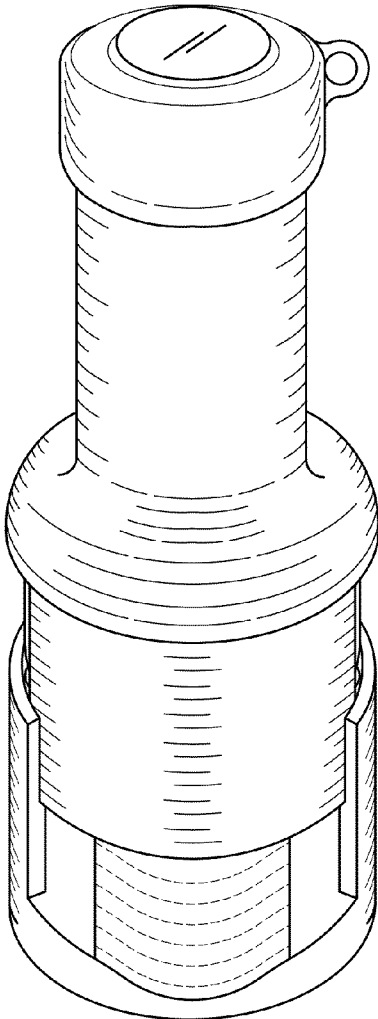

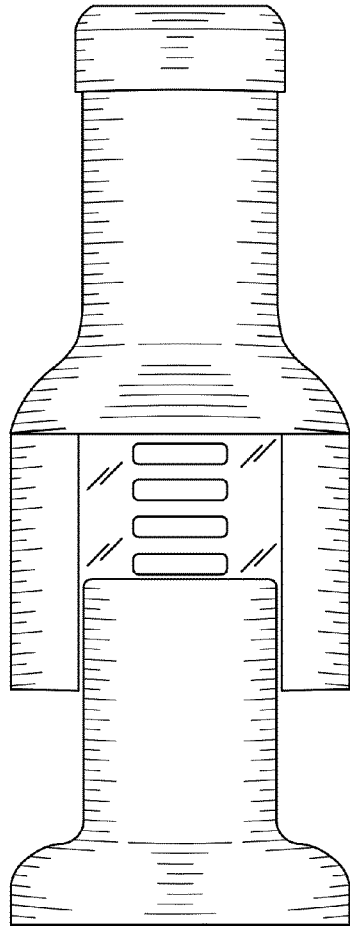

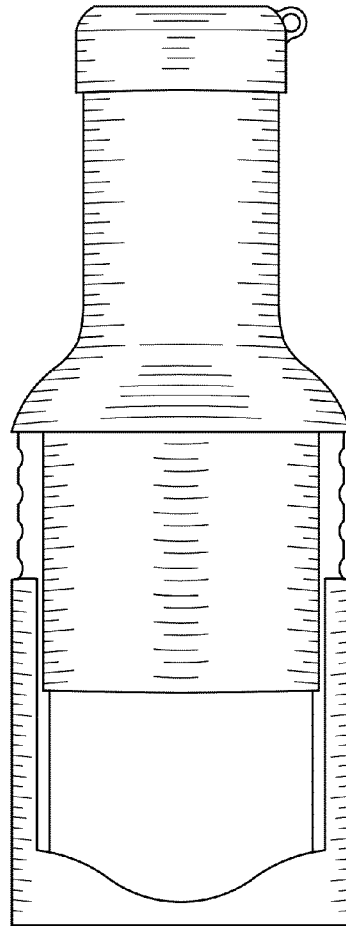

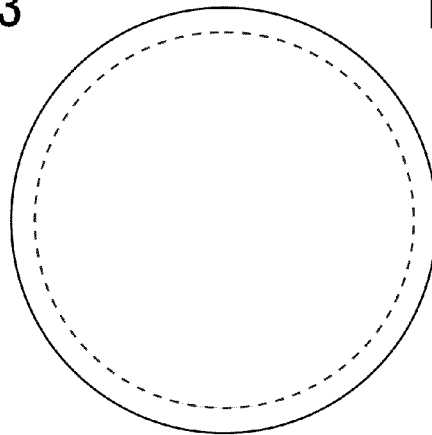
