

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a housing for a mail handling machine, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a housing for a mail handling machine showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the housing for a mail handling machine shown in FIG. 1.
















