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(54) Title: METHOD FOR IMPROVING THE BIOAVAILABILITY OF ORALLY DELIVERED THERAPEUTICS

(57) Abstract: The disclosed invention is a method and composition for improving the bioavailability of a pharmaceutically active ingredient comprising an oral dosage form consisting essentially of a granulation of active ingredient, amino acid, and hydrophilic polymer, wherein the granulation is dispersed in an immediate release or extended release excipient.
