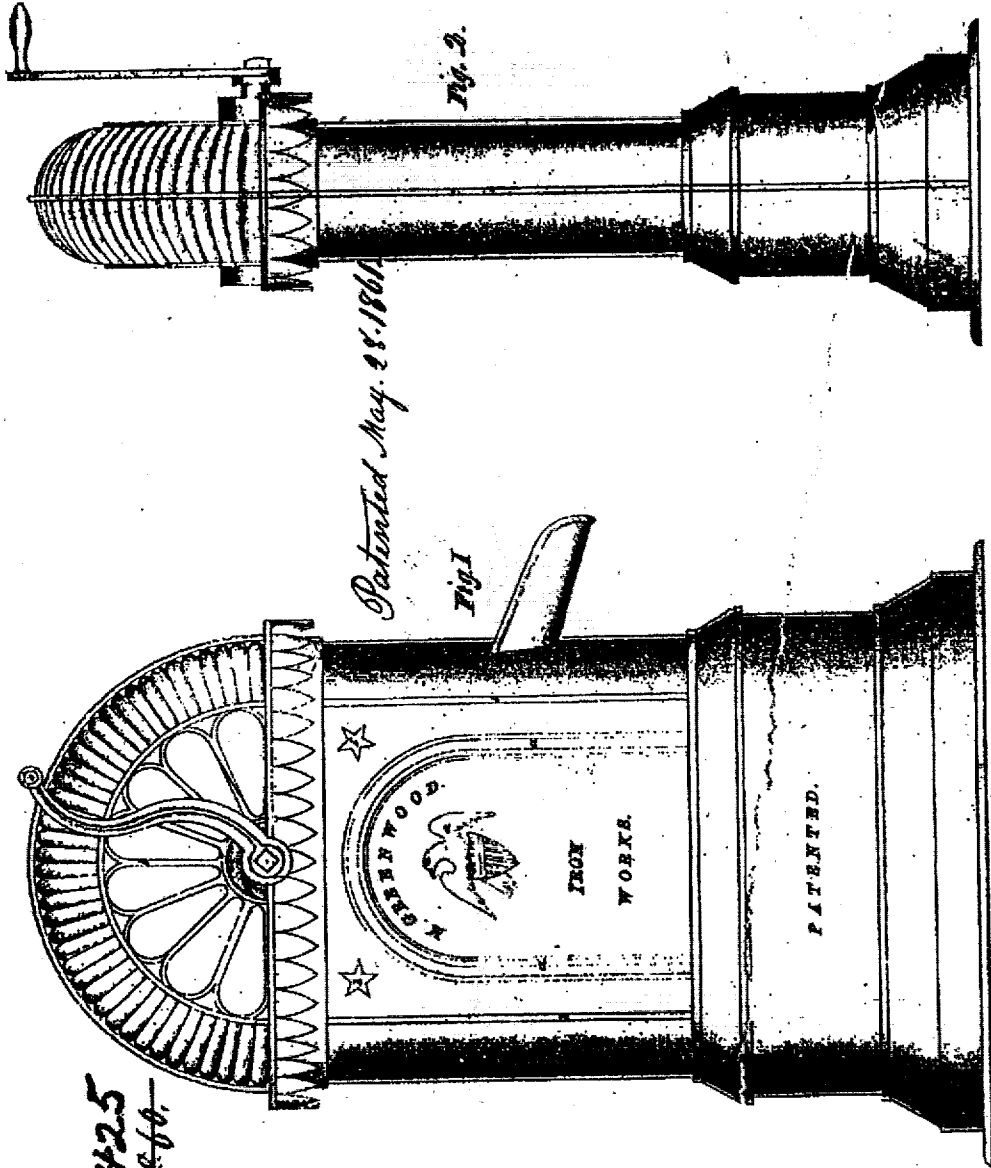

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Miles Greenwood, of Cincinnati, County of Hamilton, and State of Ohio, have invented and produced a new design for a Chain Pump Curb, and I do hereby declare that the following is an exact description of my invention and production, reference being had to the drawings attached to this specification and forming a part of the same. by figures and letters as follows, viz:

Fig. 1. is a front elevation, and

Fig. 2, a side view of my new design for a Chain Pump Curb, Fig. 1. shows principally what I claim as my new design having the Eagle and Shield, enclosed in an arched panel, the mouldings of which panel together with all parts marked a are in demi relief on a plain ground; the parts marked b, as also the letters "M. Greenwood" "Eagle" (the figure suggesting the words) "Iron Works" "Cincinnati O", and also the word "Patented &c", on the base of the Curb, being in Baso relief. The character of the design being more plainly exhibited by the drawings than could well be expressed by any description.

What I claim as my invention and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is the design above described consisting of an Eagle and shield enclosed in an arched panel in demi relief the whole being substantially as represented.
